

RESPONSIVE READING based on Genesis 1:1-2:4

In the beginning when God created the heavens and the earth, the earth was a shapeless void and darkness covered the face of the deep, while a wind from God swept over the face of the waters. Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light.

And God saw that the light was good.

On the second day, God created the earth and the sky.

And God saw that it was good.

On the third day, God created the seas and the dry land, and plants to grow on the land.

And God saw that it was good.

On the fourth day, God created the sun and moon, planets and stars.

And God saw that it was good.

On the fifth day, God created living creatures to fly in the sky, and swim in the sea, and move over the land.

And God saw that it was good.

On the sixth day, God said, "Let us make human beings in our image, to be like us." So human beings were created in God's own image, in the image of God they were created, both male and female in the image of God.

God saw everything that was made and indeed, it was very good.

And on the seventh day, God rested.

SCRIPTURE LESSON 2 Corinthians 13:11-13

This text is Paul's final blessing to the people of Corinth. It is important not only because he describes how Christians live together, but also because it mentions the three parts of God we have come to know as "The Trinity."

Finally, brothers and sisters, farewell. Put things in order, listen to my appeal, agree with one another, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you. Greet one another with a holy kiss. All the saints greet you. The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God, and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with all of you.

GOSPEL READING Matthew 28:16-20

Now the eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had directed them. When they saw him, they worshiped him; but some doubted. And Jesus came and said to them, "All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go therefore and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything that I have commanded you. And remember, I am with you always, to the end of the age."

We lift them to the lord.


